Competition to celebrate the Queen's 90th birthday

With the approval and agreement of the Archbishops of Canterbury and York, every parish church in England is being encouraged to organise a festival on the weekend of 10-12 June 2016 to celebrate the Queen's 90th birthday and her role as head of the Church of England. This will coincide with official celebrations taking place in London.

The Queen's birthday presents a great opportunity to ensure that Church schools are celebrated as part of the festival. To help promote this, the Church Education Office is running a competition for the design of a logo, to be used on all the publicity surrounding the national Church of England celebrations. The logo should aim to communicate the link between church, school and the birthday celebrations.

Parents' SEN Information Evening

On Tuesday 19th January at 6.30pm, Mrs Baker will be running an information evening about Special Educational Needs (SEN) provision within our school. The purpose of the evening is to inform you of the support we give to those with SEN and how this links with the sessions led by outside professionals. It is also to provide an overall understanding of the process involved with identification of SEN need through to the implementation of different interventions and support. You will hear about how we provide for SEN needs within the mainstream classroom setting. The evening is for anyone who has a child identified as having SEN or for any of you who may consider your child to have additional needs that are not yet identified.

At the end of the evening, there will be a time for questions and answers. Please would you email the school office (office@cds.bucks.sch.uk) with any questions you already have, as these can then be incorporated into the session. At the end of the evening you will be able to book a 1:1

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appointment with Mrs Baker to discuss the particular needs of your child or any SEN concerns you may have. There will be a sign-up sheet available.
