Coronavirus

I wanted to let you know how we are managing the coronavirus threat in school. I receive and read the daily updates from Public Health England and the DFE, and we are liaising with other local schools. The current position is for schools to remain open and for trips and visits to continue as normal. We are encouraging children to wash their hands regularly and to use tissues, thank you to Dr Faller for helping us to bring home this message to the children. The school premises are cleaned thoroughly every night, and the school caretaker is regularly cleaning desks and door handles with Milton.

Mr Ecott (Chair of Governors) and I have an emergency plan in place, should we need it. If it becomes necessary to close for any reason, we will notify you of school closure in the same way we would if we close for any reason (Twitter, Mix 96, Bucks County Council and email). Should we be closed for more than 2 days, we will ensure that school work is available for the children through the usual homework methods: MyMaths, Learning Logs and TTRockstars.
