Learning Log Project

Your next project title is:

Easter – What does it mean?

This is an open-ended project. You can be as creative as you like.

Possible options – reading and retelling 'The Easter Story', designing and making your own Easter egg, creating your own Easter egg hunt with written clues (these clues could be maths questions), life cycles, planting, Easter baskets, baking, craft activities or writing your own Easter prayer.

Think about different light sources and the difference between natural and artificial light. Make two lists, one of natural light sources eg. fireflies and the second of artificial light sources eg. a torch
