

Dear parents,

Phew- initial assessments are over! The children have coped well with the work they have had to do. This has helped the teachers enormously and they are now able to plan and target any missed areas of learning.

Please find attached a form to apply for Free School meals. If you are in receipt of Universal Credit and have an income below £7,400; or are in receipt of Child Tax Credit with an annual income of no more than £16,190, then you could be eligible. This eligibility enables the school to receive funding for your child. We are able to use this to pay for a number of things- eg. music lessons, clubs, Morning and Night Owls or payment towards school trips.
