Appointments during school time

We would really appreciate it if you could book appointment for your child in the afternoon, so that they don't have to be readmitted back into school. We will not always have a member of staff on the front desks and you may have to wait until someone else is available.

Morning and Afterschool care

Morning Owls is our name for Breakfast club. We offer breakfast club provision for our pupils whose parents find a slightly earlier start helpful; this is available to children on both sites. At the Infant site this opens at 8.15am and on the Junior site slightly earlier at 8:00am, breakfast is provided followed by a variety of activities. To book your child into Morning Owls please use the School Gateway App.

£4 per session

Night Owls is our name for After school club. This is available also on both sites. Children are able to attend as many, or as few sessions are you require. The club runs from the end of the school day until 5:30pm for Infants and 5:45pm for Juniors. A drink and snack are provided, followed by games and activities. Again, this is booked through the School Gateway App. (Children can attend Night Owls following participation at an afterschool club) **£10 per session**
