

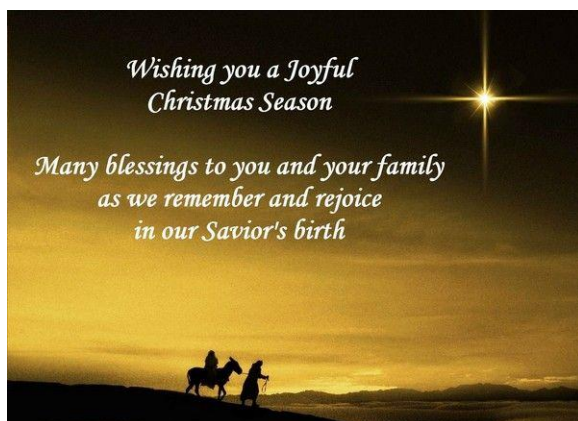


School Newsletter

COVID infections

There are now have 3 members of staff with COVID (all with mild cold like symptoms), who will be out of isolation in time to spend Christmas with their family; 1 members of staff is waiting for the results of PCR tests and 1 more who is COVID free but unwell.
