Congratulations to all children for working so hard throughout the year, we have seen a huge improvement in their attainment. In Year 1, the children achieved 100% in their Phonics Screening, in Year 4 pupils scored an average of 24.2 out of 25 in their Multiplication Tables Check (MTC). Finally, Year 6 finished their time in junior school with astounding SATS results. We achieved significantly above the national average, placing us in the top 8% of schools nationally.

Year 5 & 6 have performed their Wizard of Oz production to delighted audiences this week. The confidence, singing skills, humour and teamwork has shone through. We undoubtedly have future stars amongst our pupils! Thanks to Mrs Thomas and Miss Holdford for working endlessly behind the scenes and preparing our pupils to shine. Thanks also to Mrs Clark for set design and props, F4CADS for refreshments and Mrs Humphreys and Ms Mockeridge for makeup.
